<u>NauticEd International Sailing Education Company</u> was the first sailing education body to be recognized as meeting the American National Standards EDU-3 and to-date remains the only sailing education body to meet the standards.

- (2) NauticEd also offers a <u>free ColRegs online Navigation Rules course</u>. The online course discusses the rules of giveway for boating. High quality graphics and animations are presented depicting possible collision situations and who should giveway.
- (3) Large sailboat chartering can be a safety issue for the non-experienced.
